## Underground Tank Setbacks



## Location Restrictions

- 10 feet from house, any generator or other appliance, and 10 feet from the property line
- If within 10 feet from a driveway, crash protection will be required
- Tank must be set within 100 feet from point of delivery vehicle

House-Mounted Regulator Restrictions

- 3 feet from any window or door
- 5 feet from any vent, anything electrical, or any basement window
